ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF'S
MOTION FOR ENTRY OF DEFAULT
JUDGMENT AGAINST
DEFENDANTS STP AMERICA, INC.
AND DONG YANG SCIENCE, INC.

Plaintiff has moved for default judgment against Defendants STP America, Inc. and Dong Yang Science, Inc. Those defendants defaulted when they did not file their answers, and the Clerk duly entered their defaults in July and November 2010. Since that time, the Court has adjudicated the matter as to the remaining individual defendants, dismissing the action as to defendant Kim and finding defendant Yang liable for both damages and injunctive relief.

The Court finds that the corporate defendants were, for all relevant purposes material to this lawsuit, inseparable from Defendant Yang, with Yang operating the corporate defendants using the same contact information and promoting the sale of the infringing products. Accordingly, Yang's consent to the jurisdiction of the undersigned magistrate judge functions as the consent of the parties who had defaulted, *see, e.g., Irwin v. Mascott*, 370 F.3d 924 (9th Cir. 2004) (litigation decisions by virtual representative can

1 bind non-party), and the findings of fact and conclusions of law previously entered against
2 Yang therefore apply to the defaulting Defendants as well, whom the Court finds to be
3 jointly and severally liable to Plaintiff, along with Defendant Yang.

4 Accordingly, the Court grants Plaintiff's motion for entry of default judgment
5 against Defendants STP America, Inc. and Dong Yang Science, Inc., and Judgment will
6 be entered accordingly.

7 IT IS SO ORDERED.
